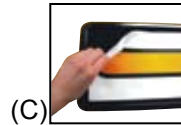
Parts List

Important: Before you begin please count and inspect all pieces.

- 1 - Panel Display (A)
- 4 - Header Display (B)
- 4 - Header Graphic (C)
- 5 - Header Connector (D)
- 1 - Soft Carry Case (E)

Assembly Instructions



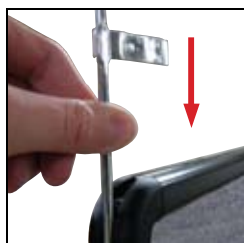
Step 1

Lay headers (B) flat on table. Place header graphics (C) Velcro™ side down, on Velcro™ receptive headers (B) of the display.



Step 2

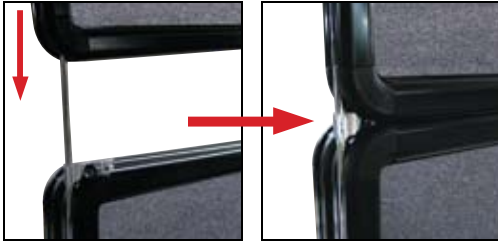
Unfold outside panels to approximately 30° angles and set on tabletop.



Step 3

Line up the connector (D) with the groove on the edge of the display (A). Push down until the connector is sitting on top of the panel (A). Repeat on all panel edges.

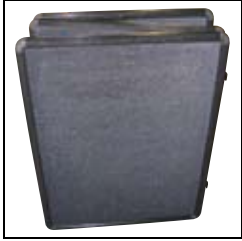
Assembly Instructions (cont.)



Step 4

Line up the groove on the edge of the header (B) with connectors (D). Slide header (B) down until it rests on top of the center panel (A). Repeat for all headers.

Disassembly Instructions



Step 1

Remove headers (B) and connectors (D) from display (A). Fold display (A) together in a zig-zag pattern, and lay flat. Leave header graphics (C) attached for quick and easy set-up next time.

Storage Instructions



Place and store all components in soft carry case (E) and store in a cool dry place.

Care Instructions

Spot clean with a damp cloth.
